Rotavirus A, C

- There are no specific treatments for rotavirus infections
- Provide antibiotic therapy either by injection, by oral feeding, to control secondary infections such as E.coli

■ Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus (PEDV) Transmissible Gastroenteritis virus (TGEV)

- Major agents in viral enteric diseases of piglets
- As the clinical signs of these diseases are similar, including watery diarrhea, differential detection is required for etiologic diagnosis
